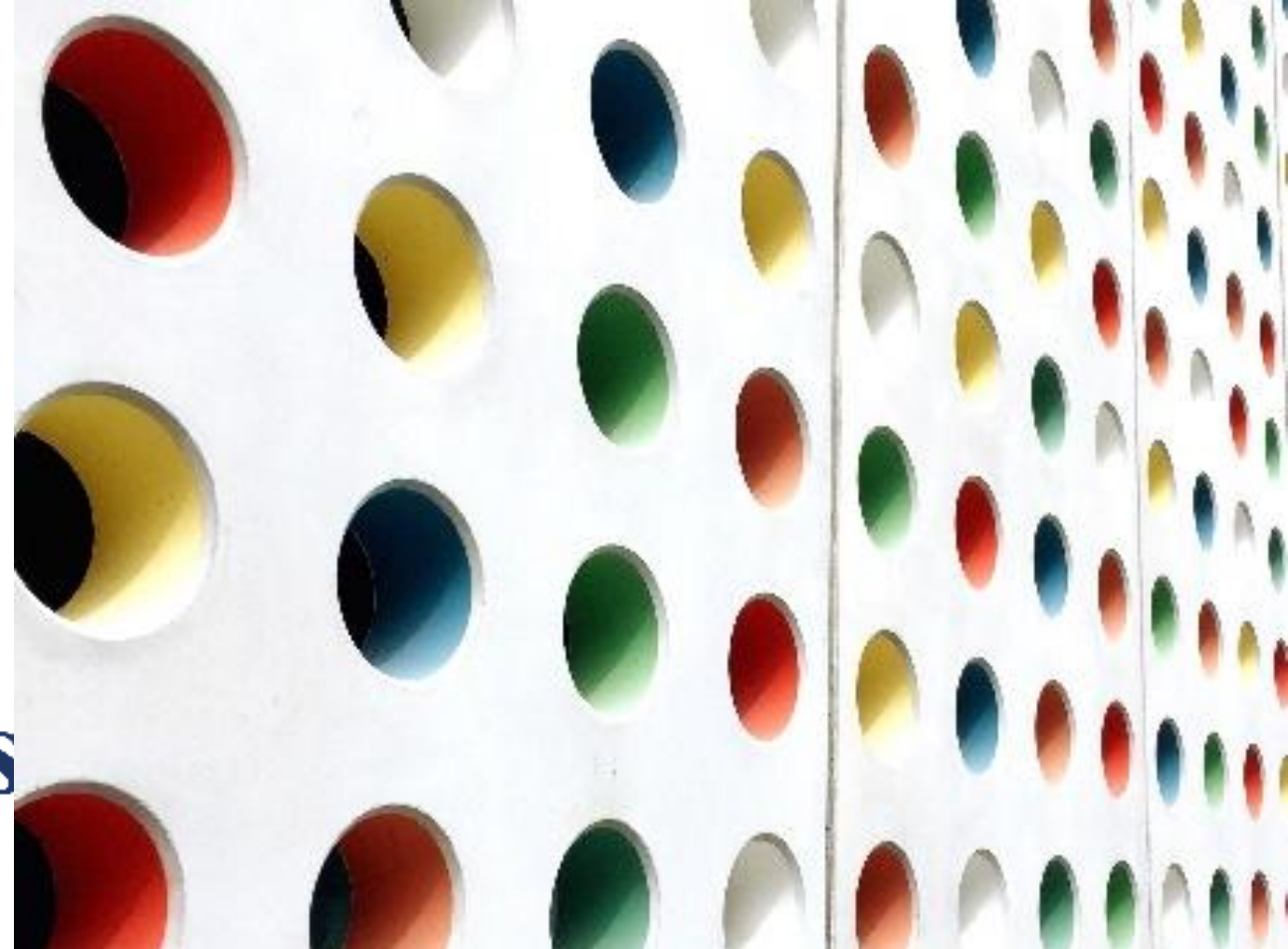

Methodology and Approach

Summary of Findings

The third NDC delegates tracking poll for July 2026 shows the national chairman of the NDC, Johnson Asiedu Nketia, losing ground alongside the vice president, Prof. Jane Naana Opoku-Agyemang, Haruna Iddrisu, minister for education, and Julius Debrah, the chief of staff, in the race to replace John Mahama for the 2028 election.

The poll shows Asiedu Nketia now leads the race with 27%, down from 29% in April 2026. Ato Forson, now on 22%, up from 19% in April 2026. Haruna Iddrisu, saw the biggest drop of support, declining from 11% to 6% in July 2026. Prof Jane Naana Opoku Agyemang, also declined from 8% to 7%, while Julius Debrah declined from 8% to 5%. Prof. Joshua Alabi, Eric Opoku and others on 1% each while 30% of the delegates are undecided, up from 24% in the April 2026 poll.

The poll shows 61% of the delegates agree to the suggestion that Asiedu Nketia should stay on as a chairman of the party while 26% disagree and 13% did not have an opinion. When delegates were asked whether they agree or disagree to the call from certain quarters that the NDC should present Ato Forson, an economist, to face Dr Bawumia, also an economist in the 2028 election, 58% of the delegates agreed to the call while 23% disagreed with further 19% not having an opinion. The poll shows that 25% of delegates who are currently voting for Asiedu also agreed that Ato Forson should represent the NDC to face Dr Bawumia, the economist.

Summary of Findings

In a head-to-head between Asiedu Nketia and Ato Forson, the race is statistically tied, with Asiedu Nketia leading with 34%, Ato Forson 33% and 33% are undecided. Asiedu Nketia led with 37% to 32% in the April 2026 poll. In a head-to-head between Asiedu Nketia and Haruna Iddrisu, Asiedu Nketia leads with 45%, Haruna Iddrisu, 16% and 39% are undecided. Asiedu Nketia led with 42% to 22% in the April 2026 poll.

In a head-to-head between Asiedu Nketia and Prof. Jane Naana Opoku Agyemang, Asiedu Nketia leads with 46%, Prof. Opoku-Agyemang, 15% and 39% are undecided. Asiedu Nketia led with 46% to 11% in the April 2026 poll. However, in a head-to-head between Asiedu Nketia and Julius Debrah, Asiedu Nketia leads with 45%, Julius Debrah, 16% and 39% are undecided. Asiedu Nketia led with 43% to 18% in the April 2026 poll.

In the swing regions (Greater Accra, Central and Western), Ato Forson leads with 29%, Asiedu Nketia, 23%, Prof. Opoku Agyemang, 8%, Haruna Iddrisu, 4%, Julius Debrah, 5%, others, 4% and 27% are undecided. In the Akan regions (Ahafo, Ashanti, Bono, Bono East, Central, Eastern, Western and Western North), Asiedu Nketia leads with 27%, Ato Forson, 25%, Prof Opoku-Agyemang, 6%, Haruna Iddrisu, 3%, Julius Debrah, 5%, others, 3% and 31% are undecided.

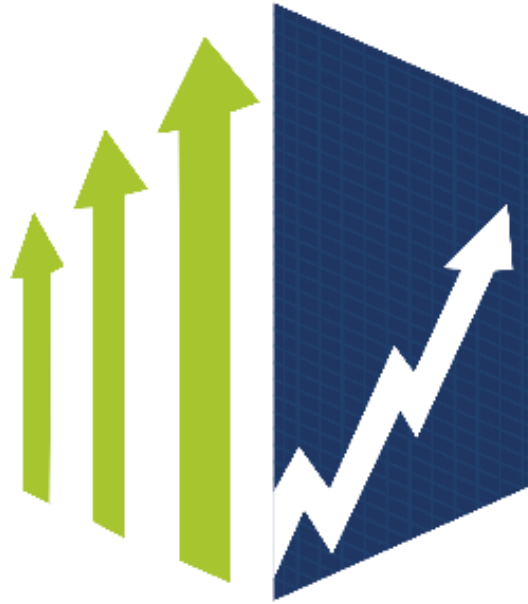
Summary of Findings

In the Volta and Oti, Asiedu Nketia leads with 24%, Ato Forson, 23%, Prof. Opoku-Agyemang, 9%, Haruna Iddrisu, 3%, Julius Debrah, 3%, others, 1% and 38% are undecided. Finally, in the northern regions, Asiedu Nketia leads with 31%, Haruna Iddrisu, 19%, Ato Forson, 12%, Prof. Opoku-Agyemang, 7%, Julius Debrah, 2%, others 2% and 27% are undecided.

Performance, visionary, served the government, personality and other factors dominate what delegates would prioritize in selecting a replacement for John Mahama, while served the party has seen a decline as a priority for delegates.

The poll also shows the race for the chairmanship gaining momentum among the grass root with Nii Lantey Vanderpuye, former MP for Odododiodioo and minister of sports, taking an early lead as the preferred candidate for chairmanship with nearly 27% of the votes. The former chairman, Samuel Ofofu-Ampofo attracts 19%, Alhaji Said Sinare, Ghana's Ambassador to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia 6%, Awudu Sorfo Azorka, current vice chairman of the party attracting 6%, Akwasi Opong-Fosu, former local government minister and the current board chairman of GIPC on 2%, and others, 4%. 36% of the delegates are undecided.

The poll was conducted between 8th July – 14th July 2026 among 5,637 NDC delegates across all the 16 regions using Computer Assisted Telephone Interviews. The poll has confidence level of 99% and a margin of error of ± 1.70

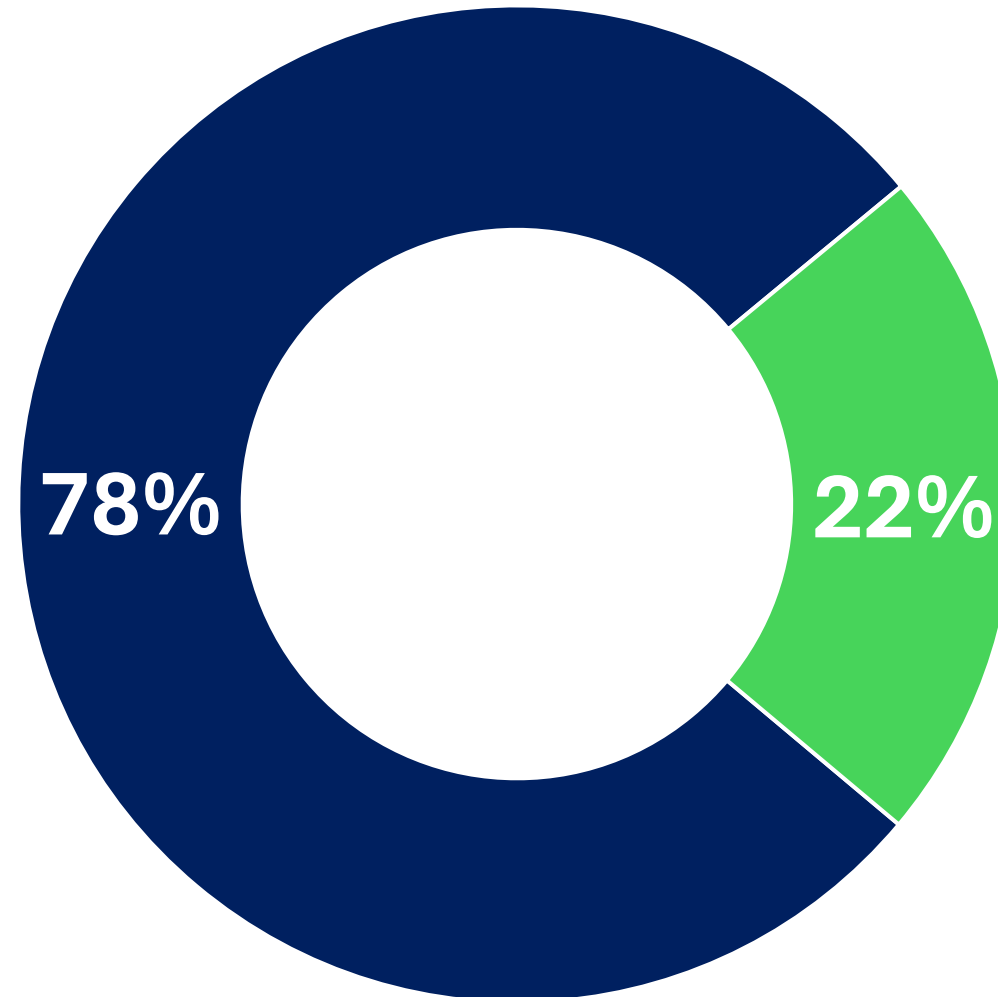


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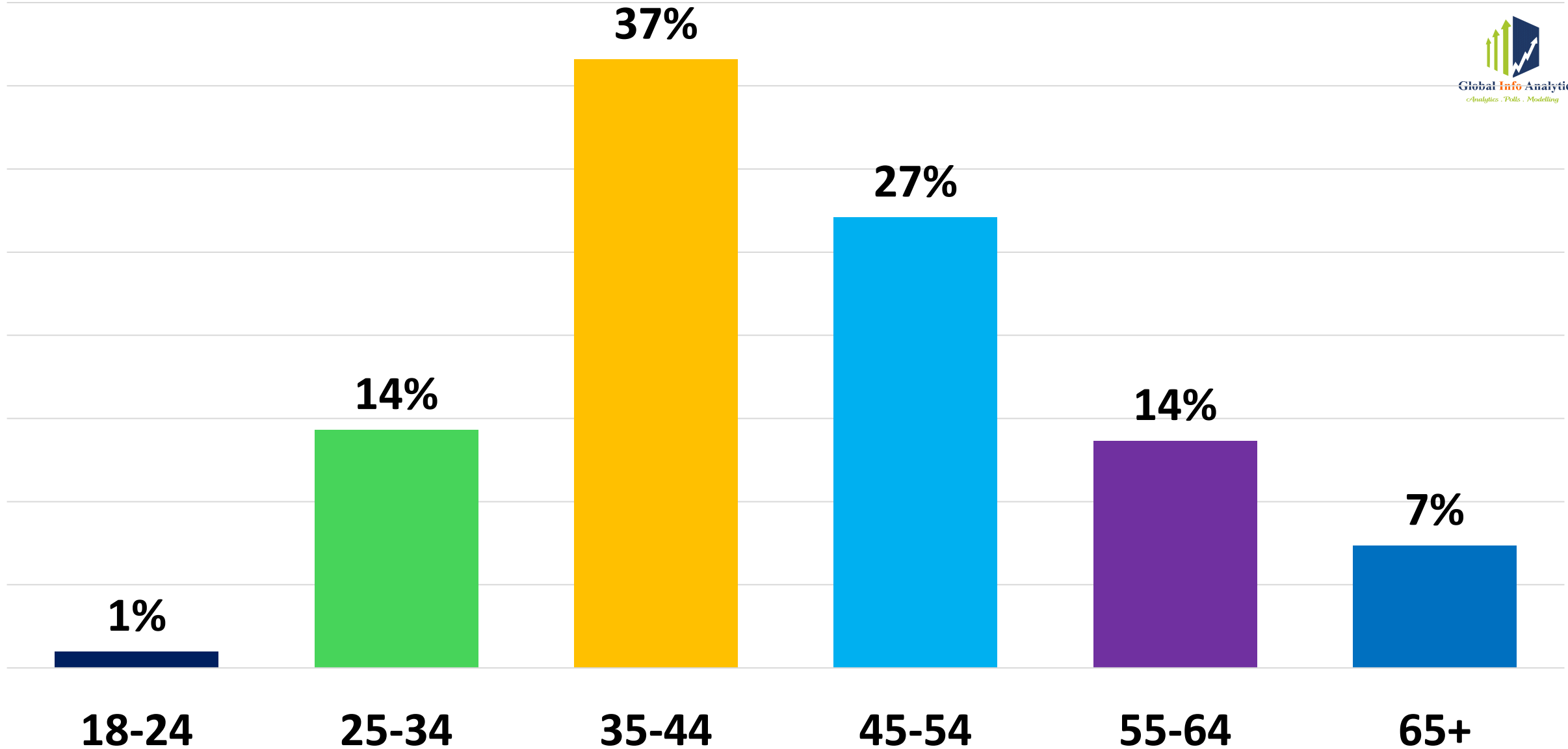

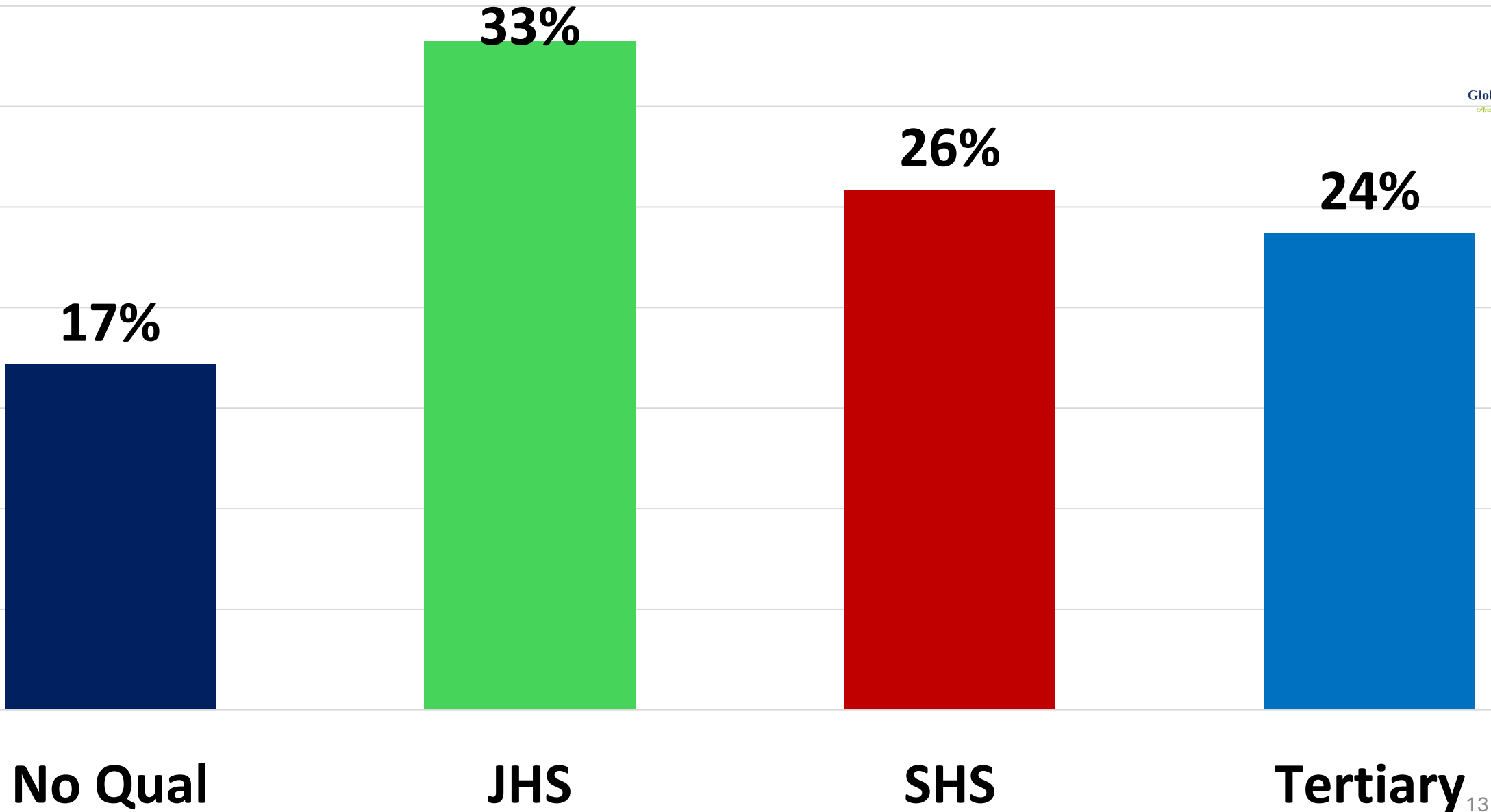

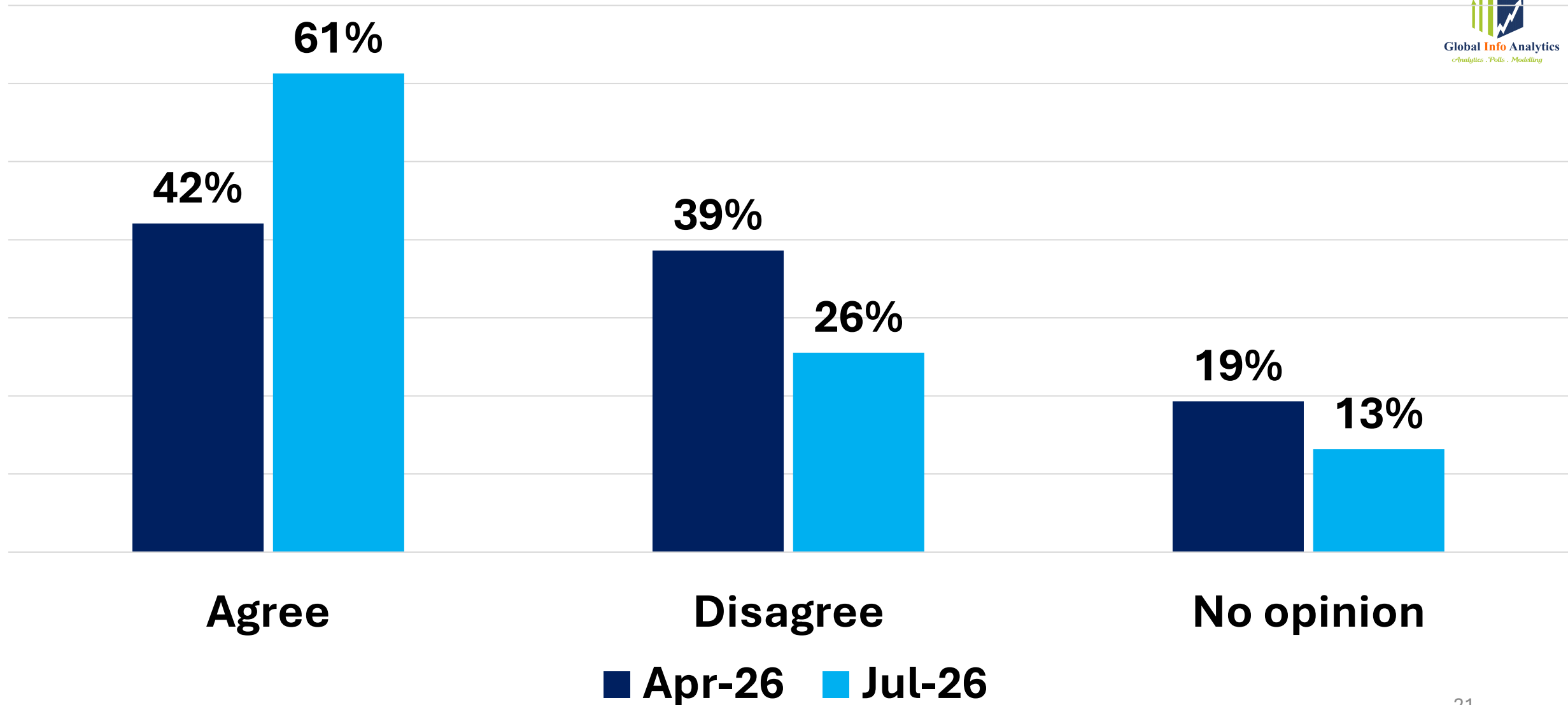

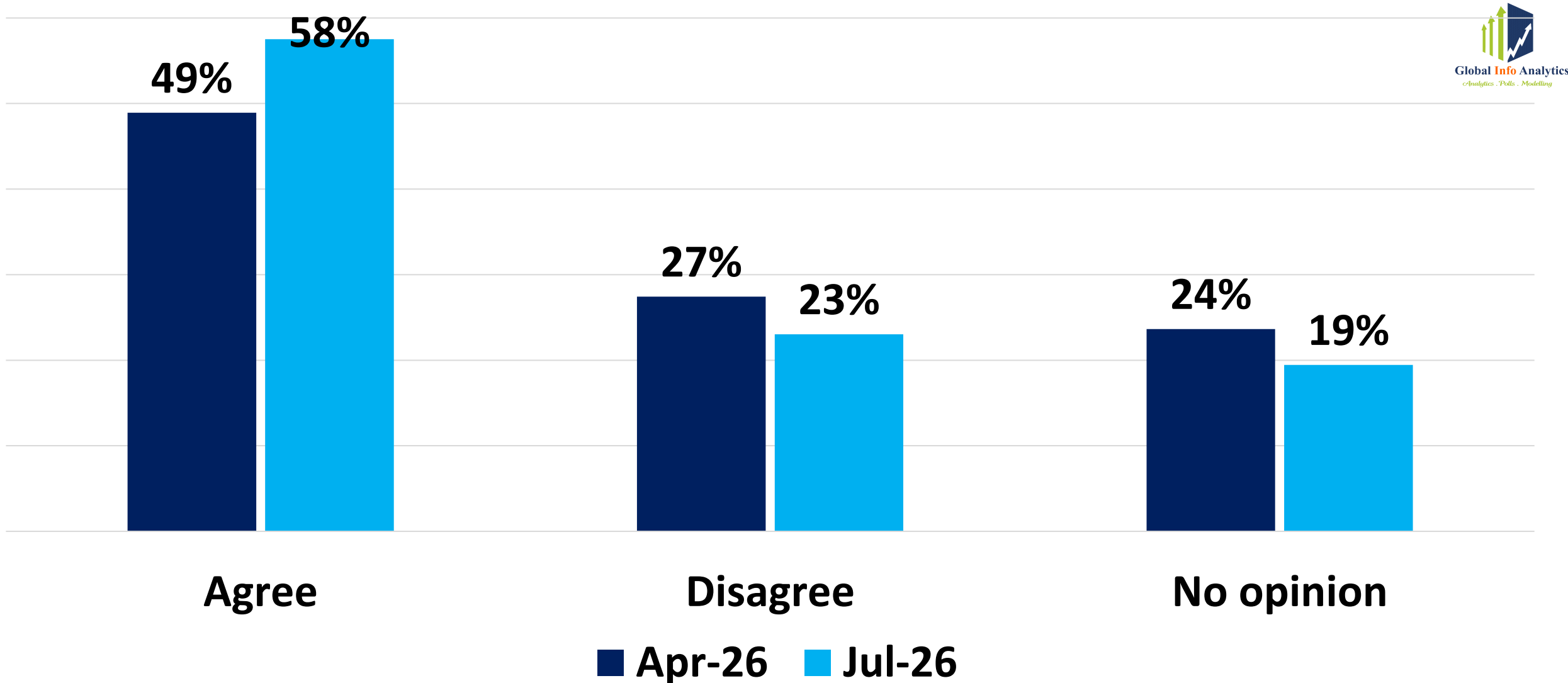

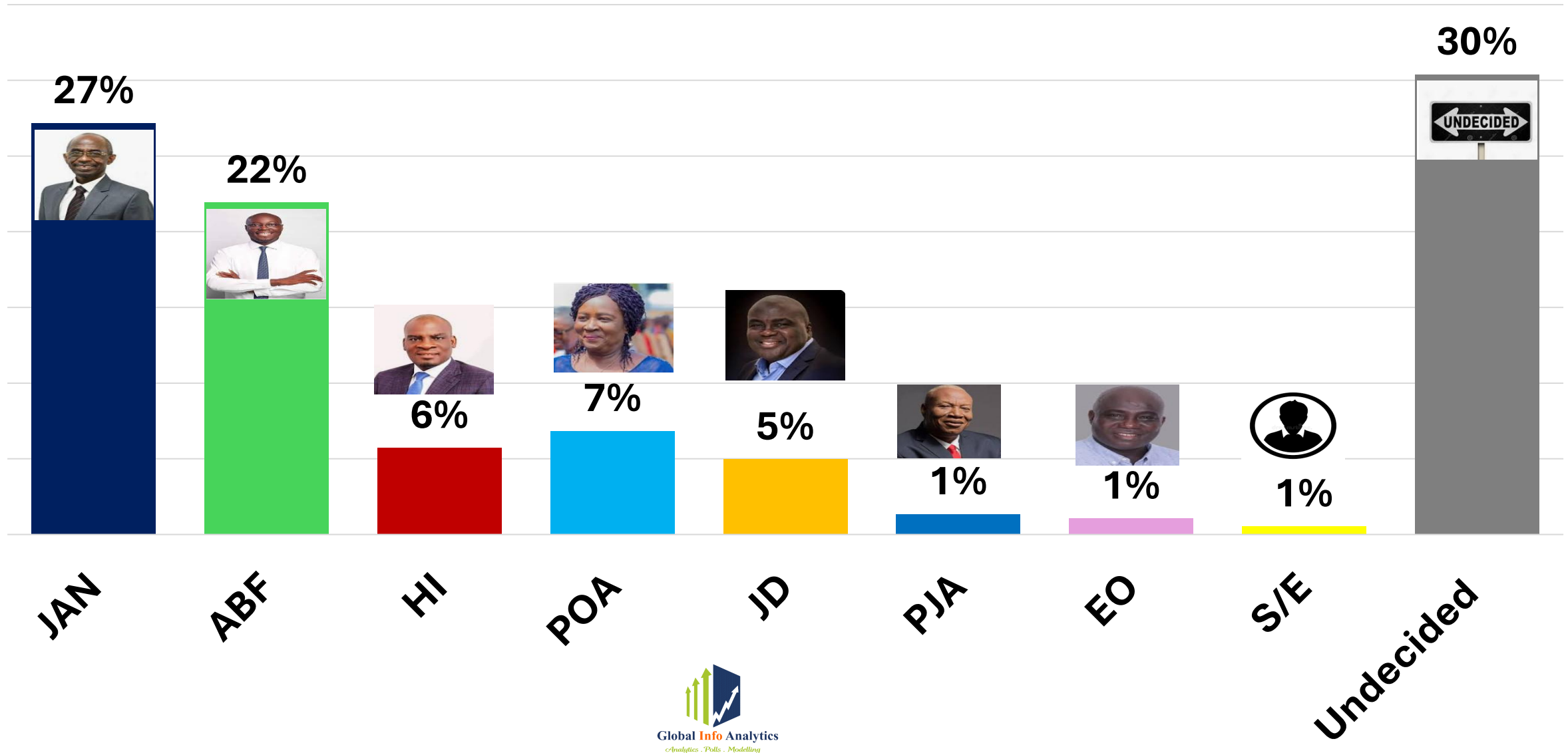

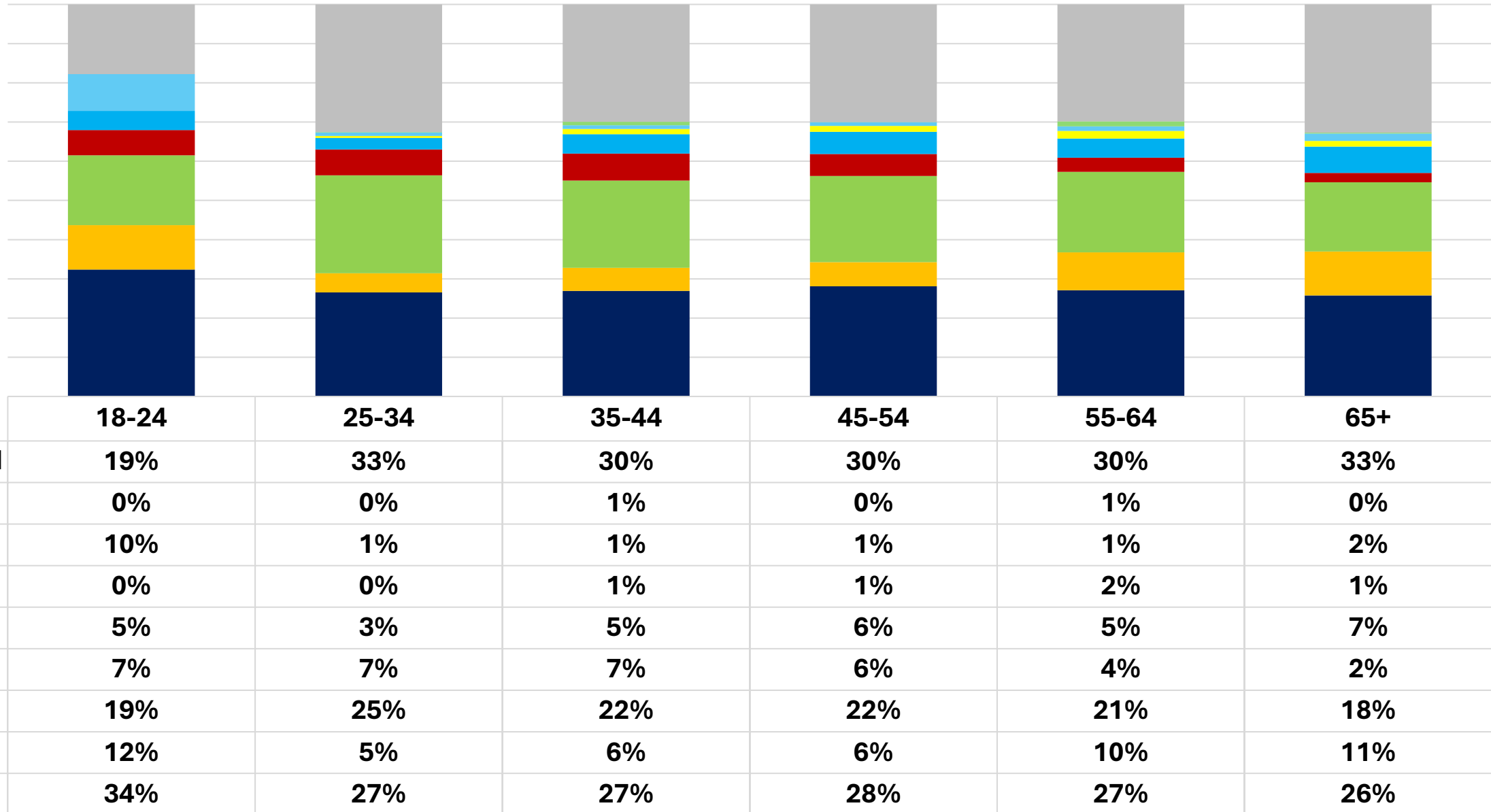

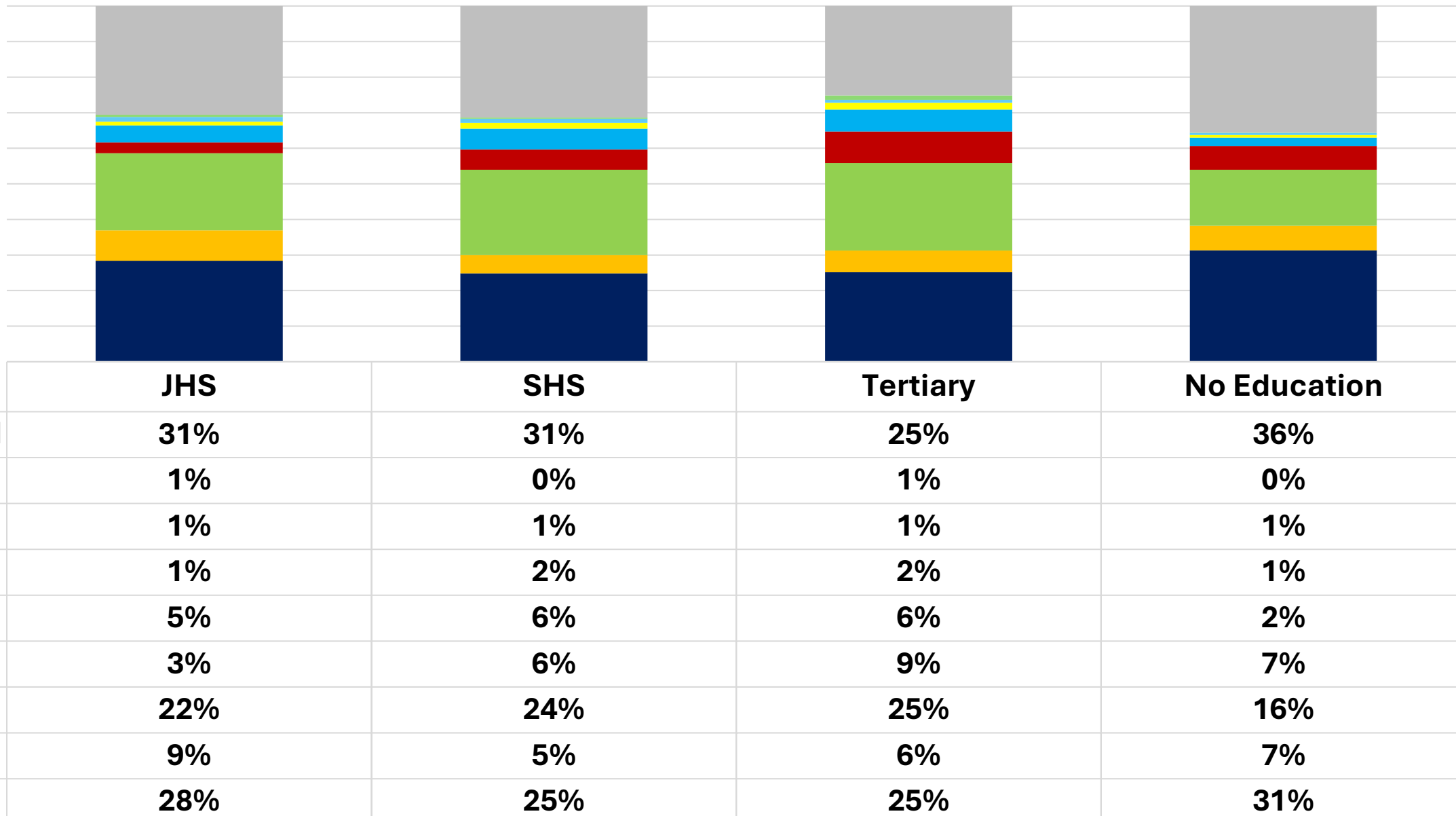

Who Leads NDC in 2028- Demographics

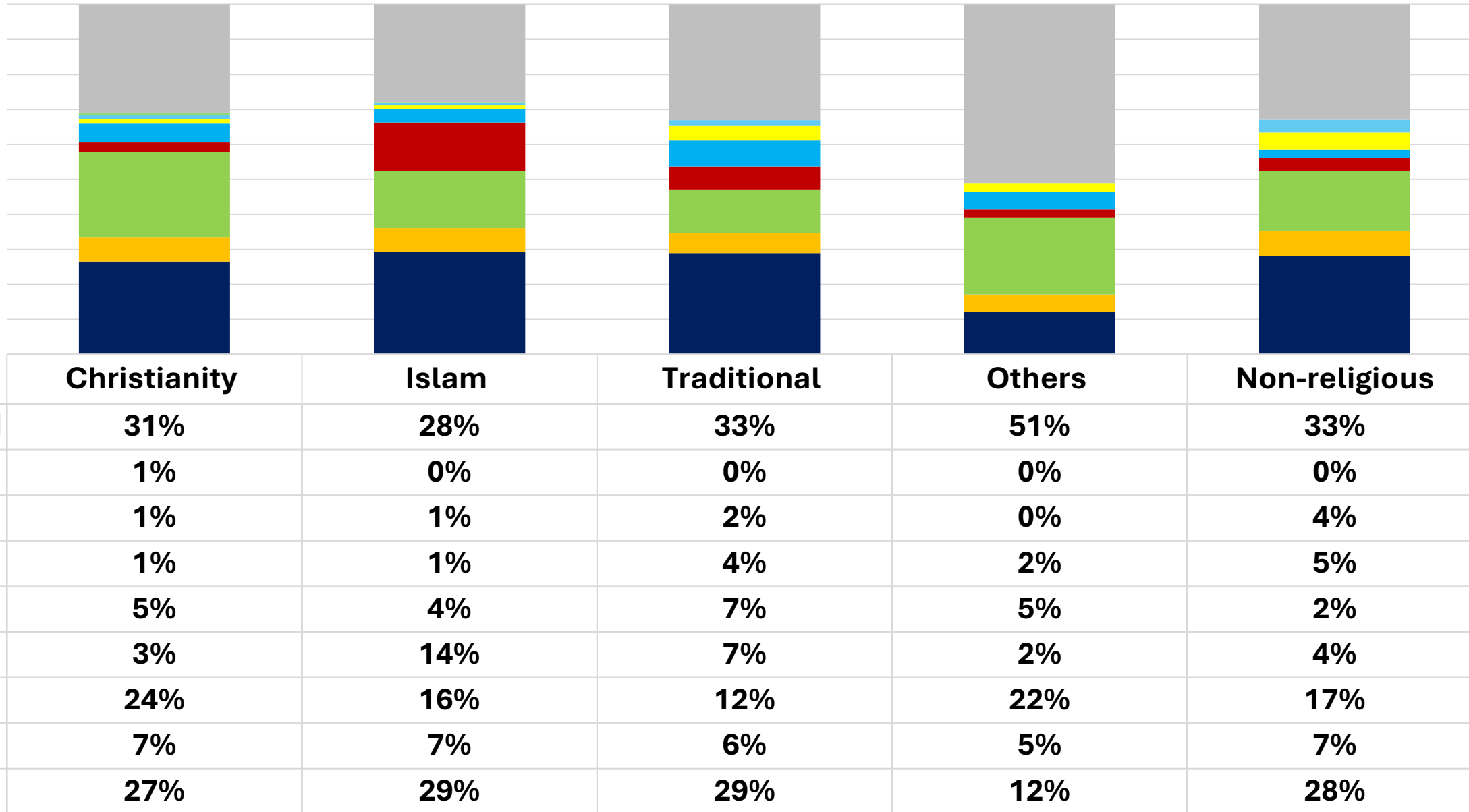
Who Leads NDC in 2028-Age



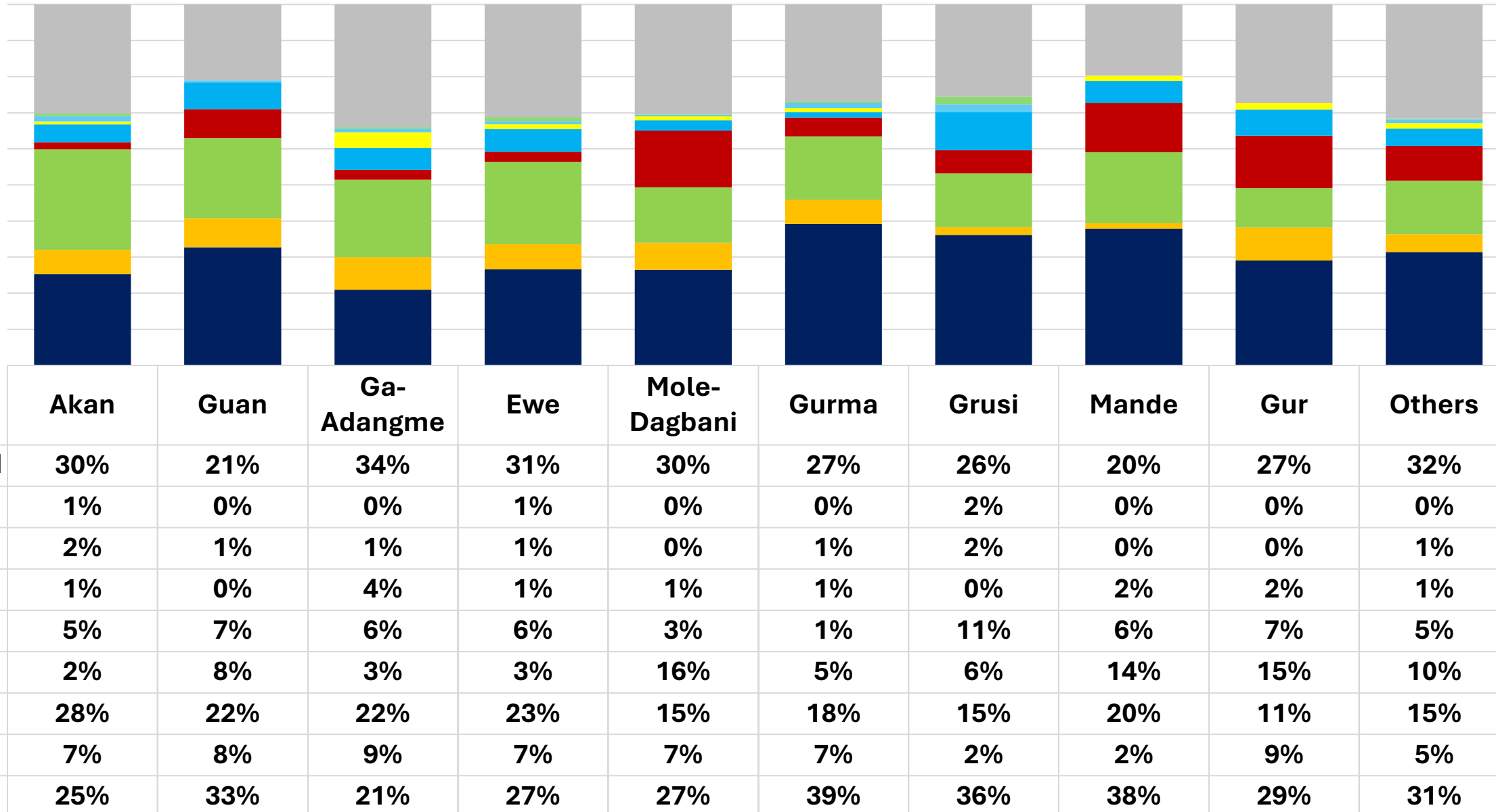
Who Leads NDC in 2028-Education



Who Leads NDC in 2028-Religion

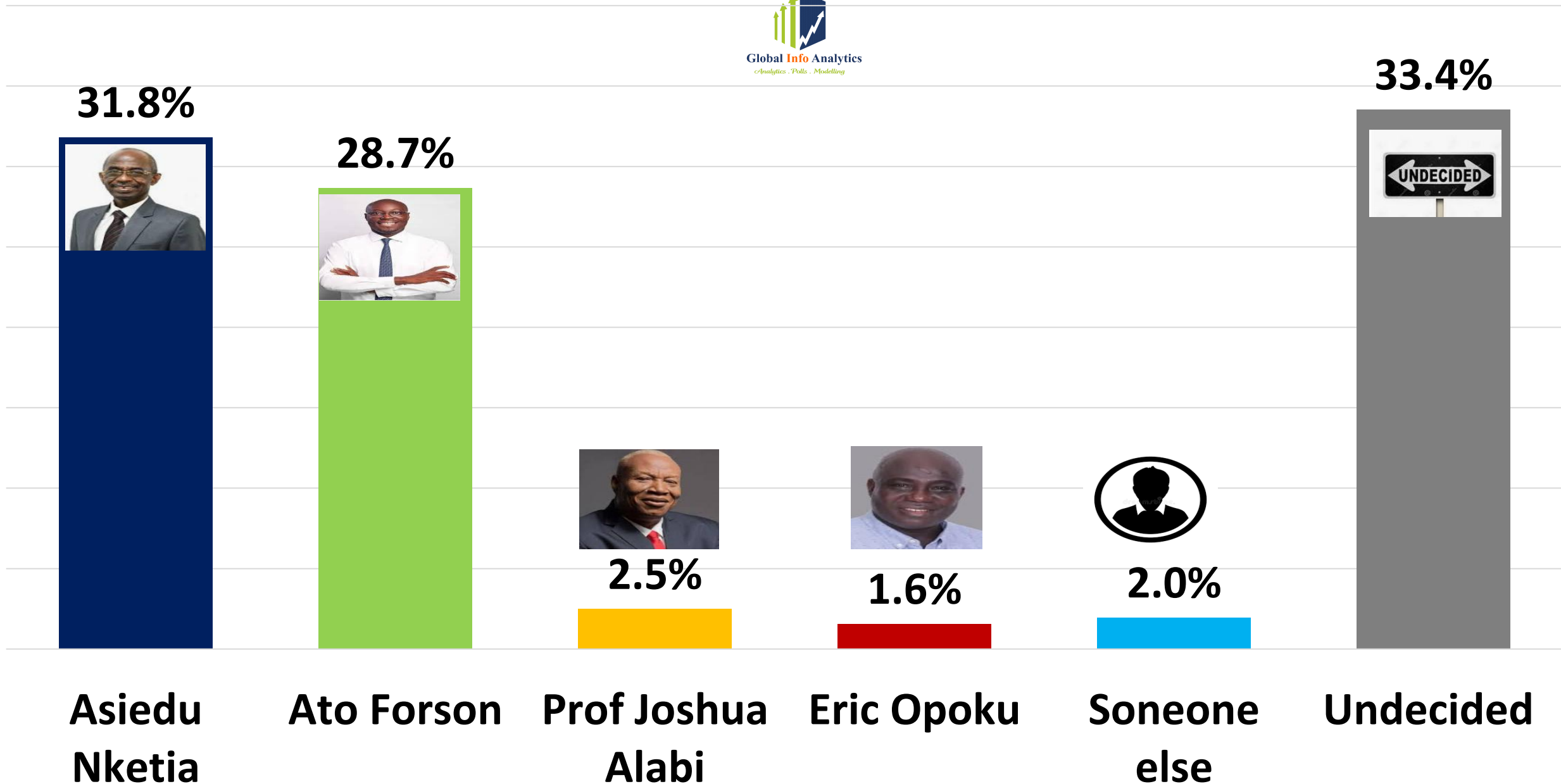


Who Leads NDC in 2028-Ethnicity



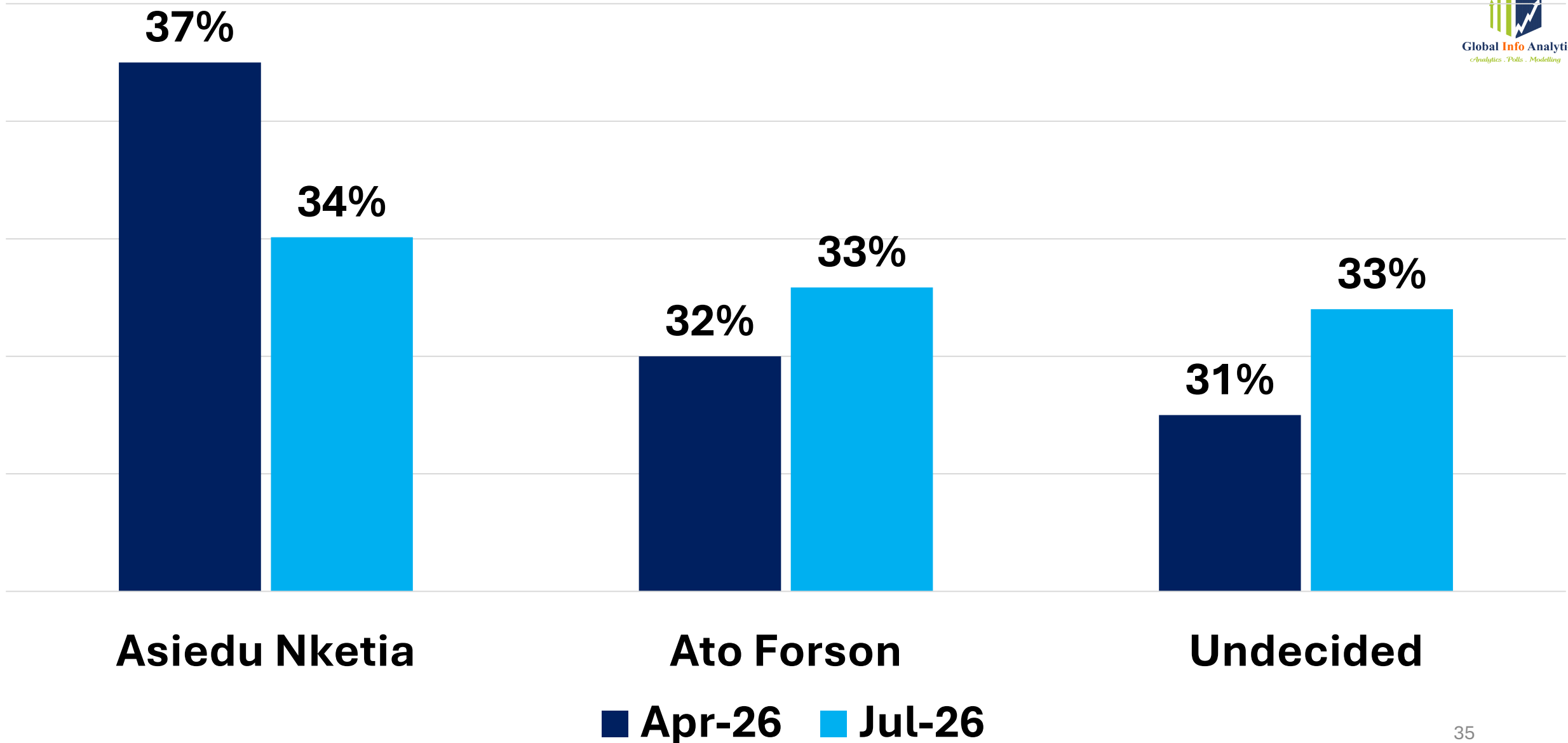

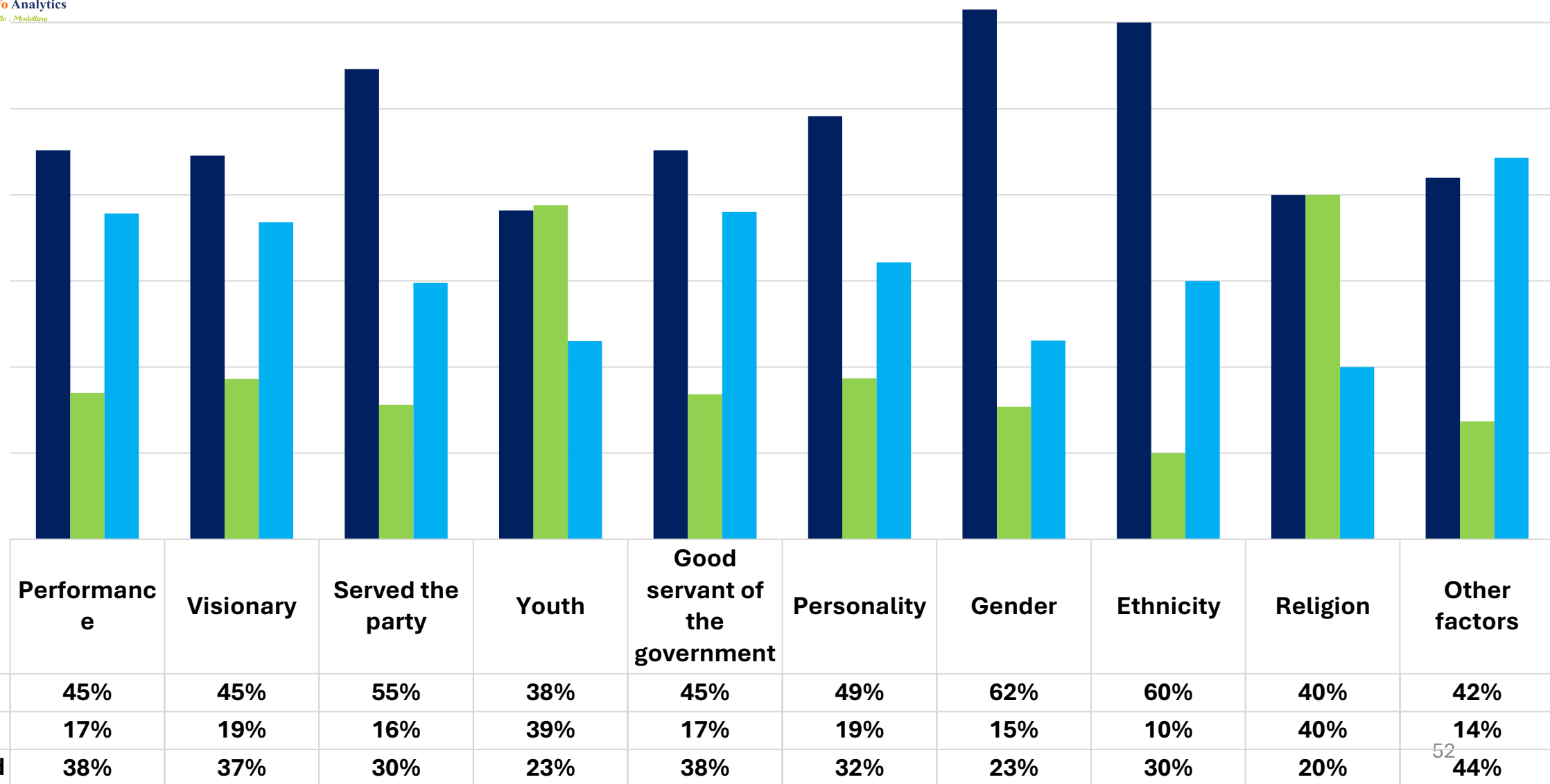

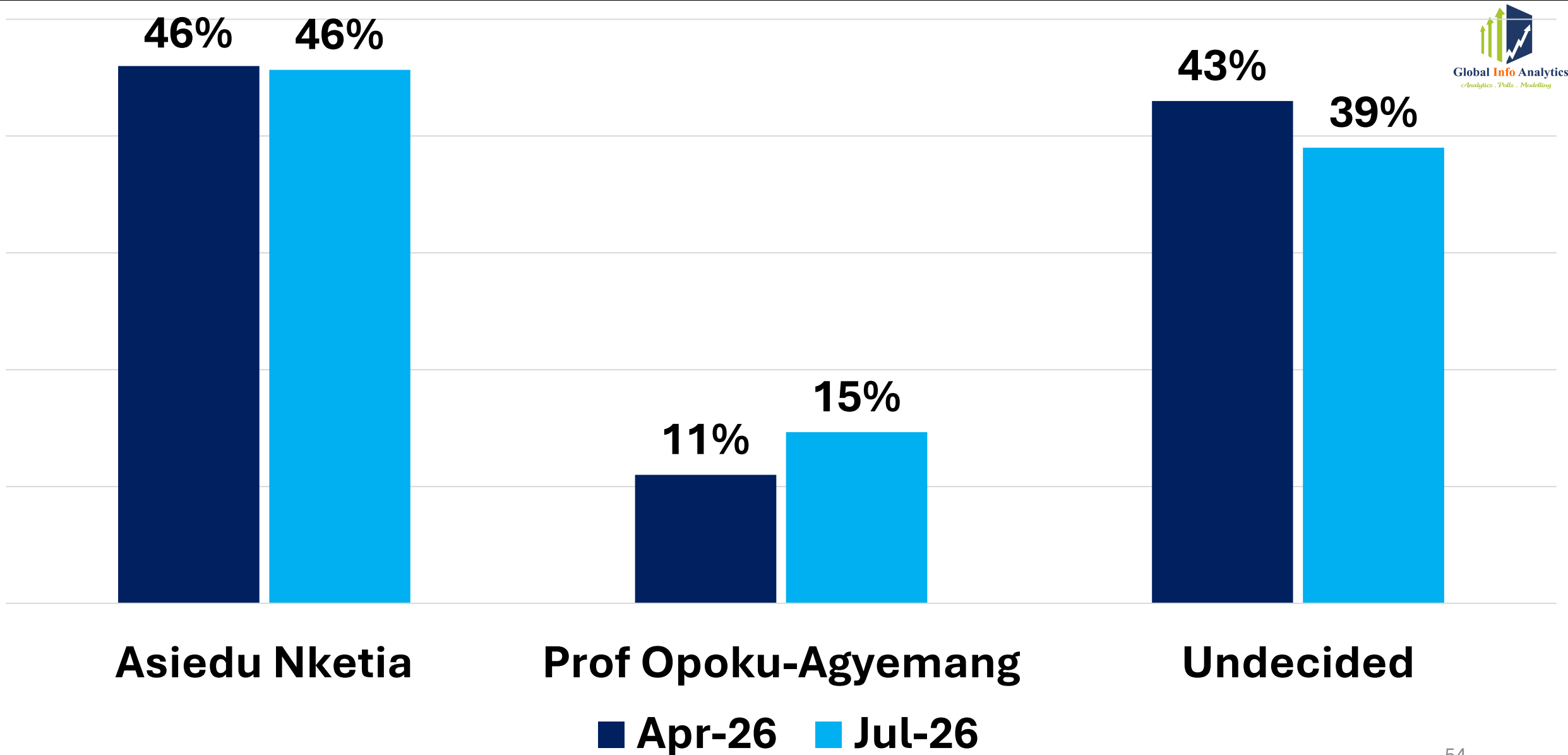

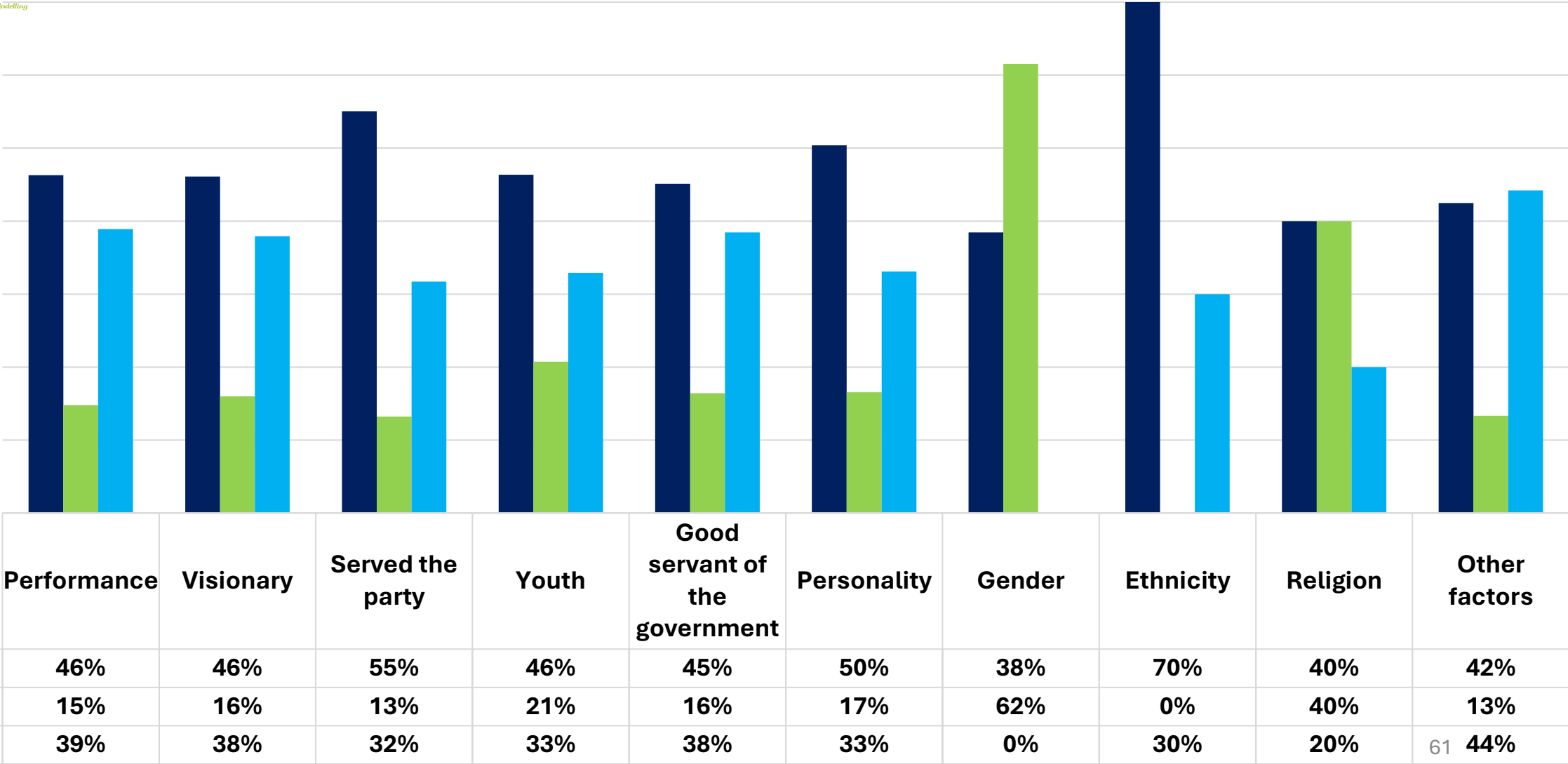

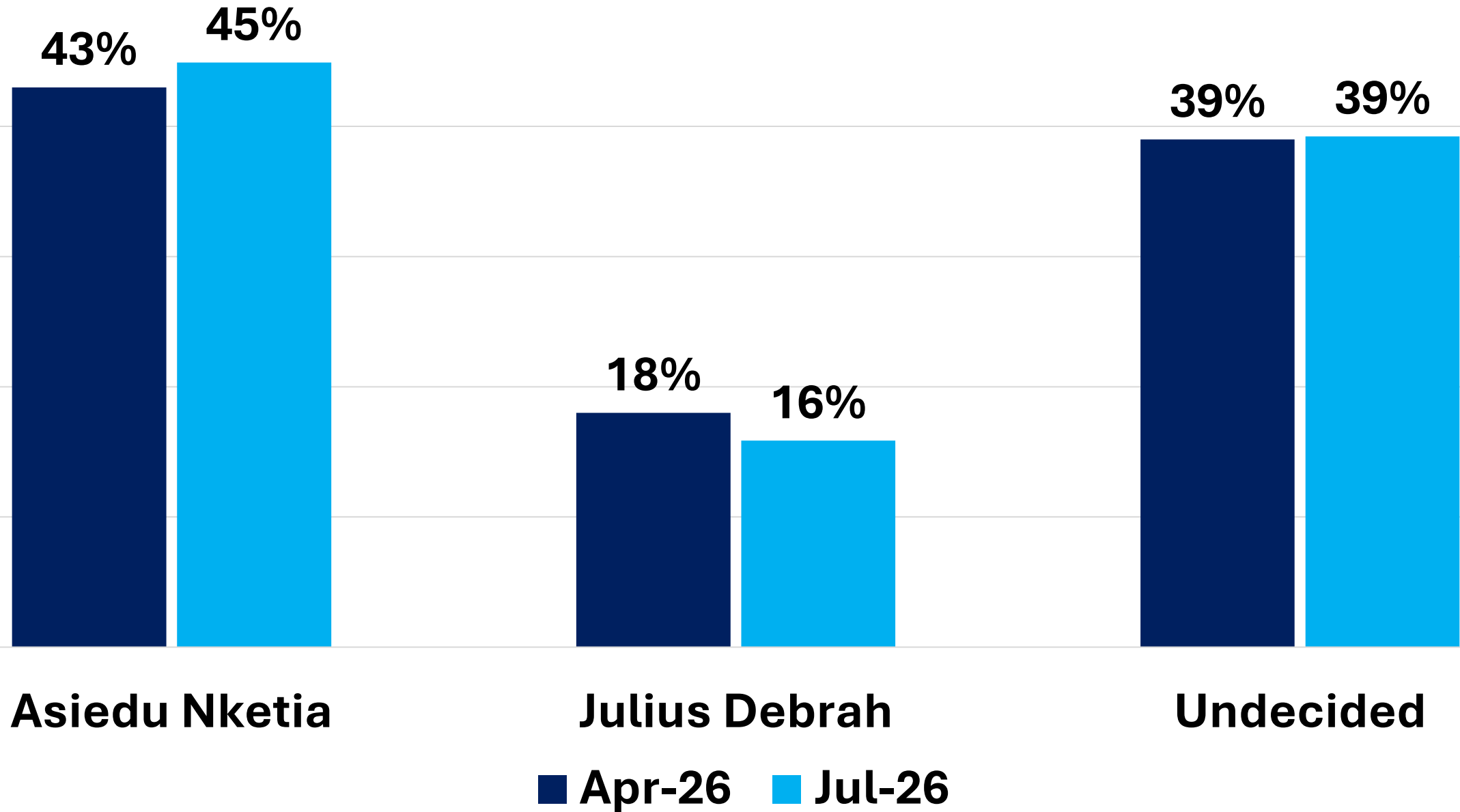

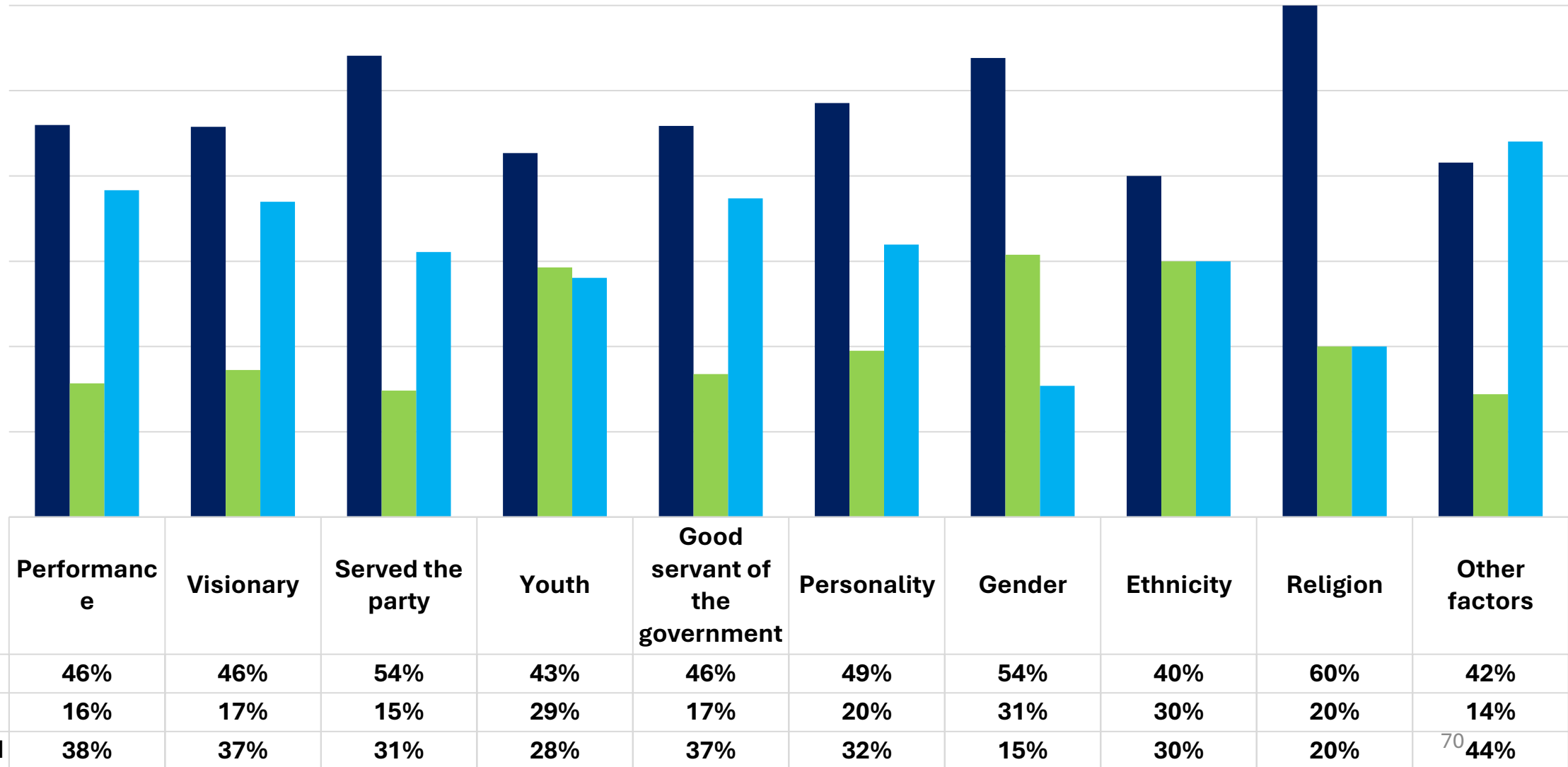

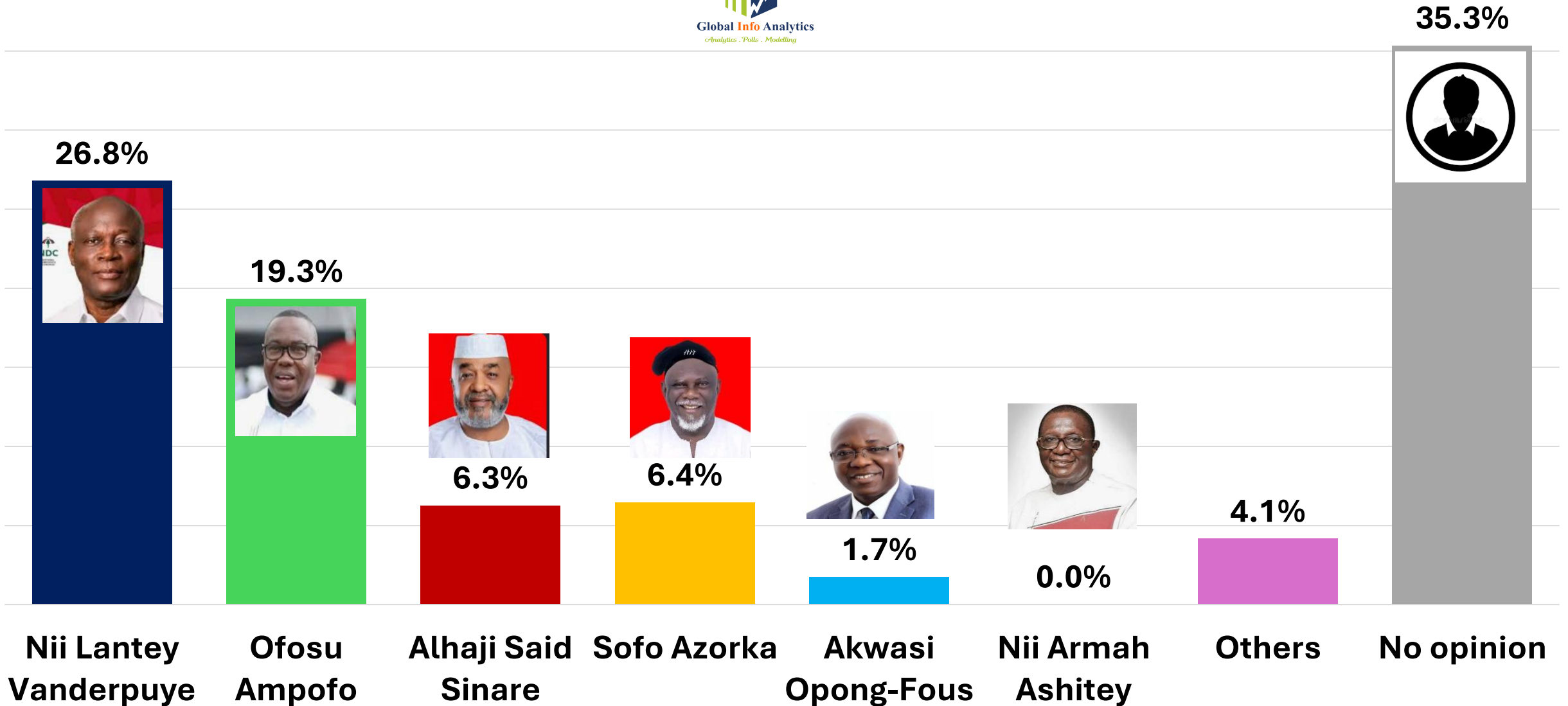
